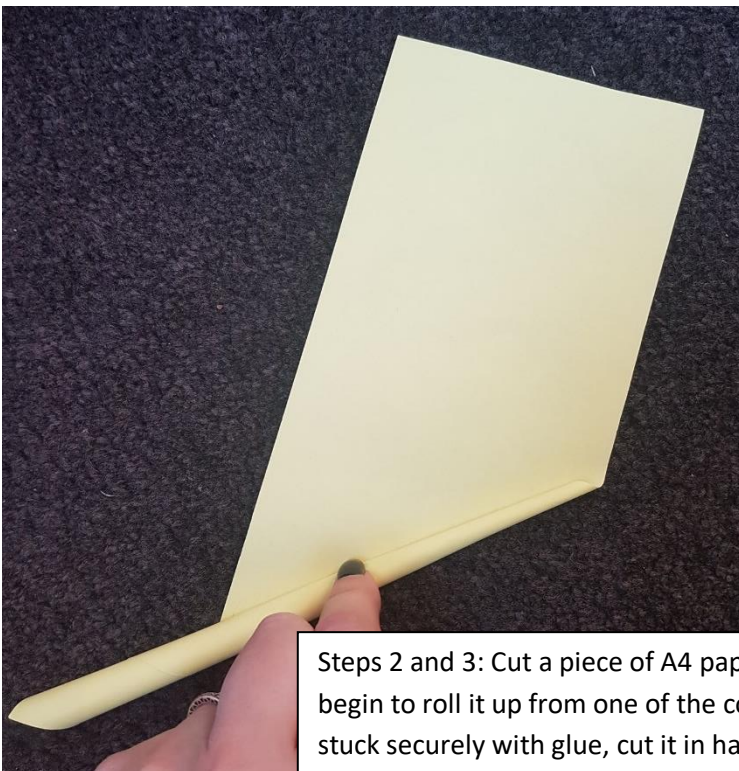


Making paper flowers

All you need is some coloured paper, some scissors, a glue stick, a few coloured pens, and a toilet roll tube.

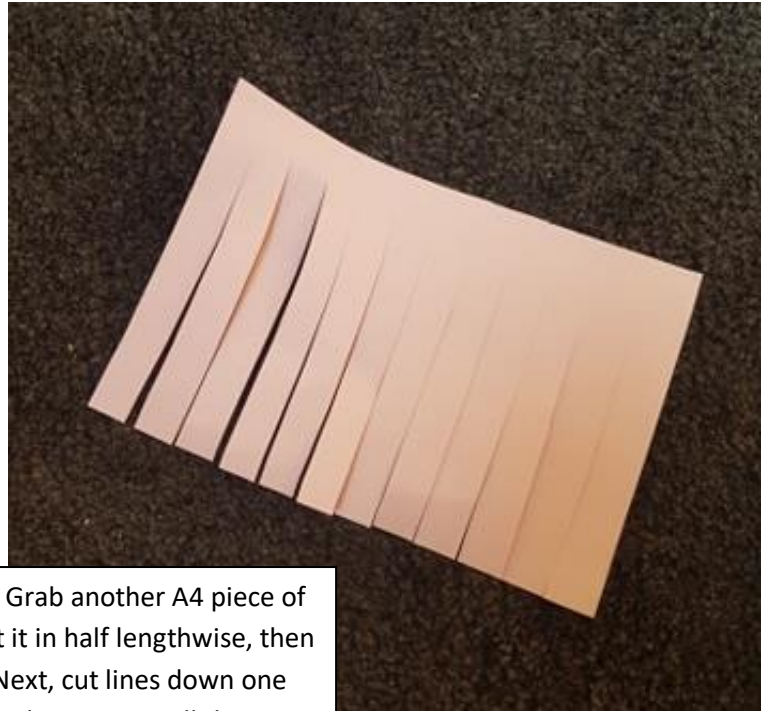
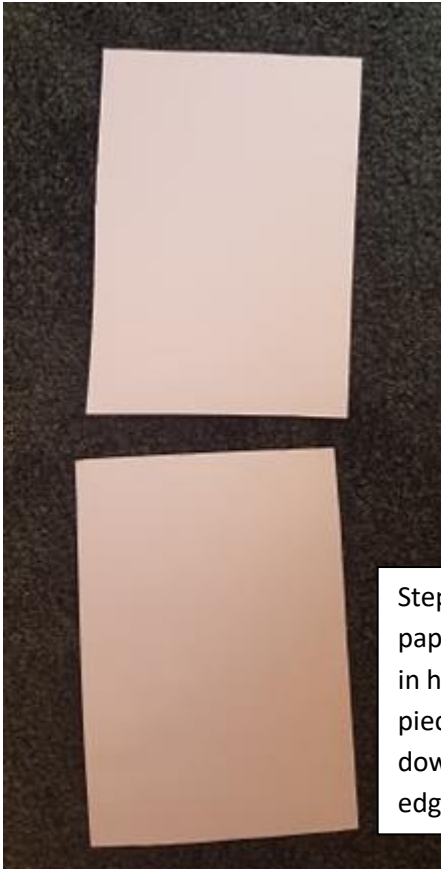


Step 1: Cut your toilet roll tube in half and then colour them in, these will be your flowerpots.

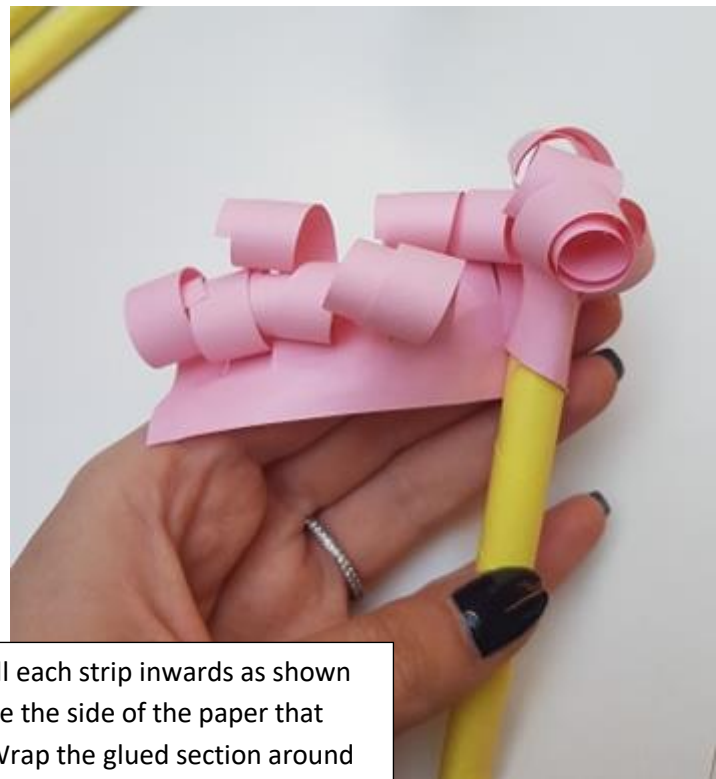


Steps 2 and 3: Cut a piece of A4 paper in half, using this half, begin to roll it up from one of the corners. Once rolled up and stuck securely with glue, cut it in half, to make two small stems.





Steps 4 and 5: Grab another A4 piece of paper, and cut it in half lengthwise, then in half again. Next, cut lines down one piece of paper, do not cut it all the way down, leave roughly an inch on the edge. These will be your petals.



Step 6 and 7: Roll each strip inwards as shown above. Then, glue the side of the paper that was left uncut. Wrap the glued section around the stem diagonally starting from the top, in order to create your flower.



You will have then created your flower, once you have made all your flowers, put them in your flowerpot!
